

## Call for Proposals for Visiting Scholars from Abroad in 2020/21 or 2021/22

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The Mandel School is happy to invite tenured members of the Faculty of Humanities to nominate senior scholars from abroad to be guest lecturers in the Faculty during the next two academic years (2020/21 or 2021/22). Guests may come either for a month or for a semester (3–6 months), and will be supplied an office in the Mandel Building, along with the usual support and. Apart from conducting their research there, they will also be expected to teach a 2-credit graduate seminar (12–14 ninety-minute sessions) and to give a public lecture.

### **Terms for full semester (3–6 months):**

- Salary: \$6000, plus \$2400/month for duration of visit
- Reimbursement for accommodations: up to \$1000 per month
- Roundtrip travel (economy class)

### **Terms for intensive course (1 month):**

- Salary: \$6000
- Reimbursement for accommodations: up to \$100 per day
- Roundtrip travel (economy class)

**Nominators whose guests are selected are expected to serve as the guests' hosts and to include them in the teaching and research activity of their departments.**

### **Applications should include the following documents:**

- Application form (attached to the Hebrew text of this document)
- A letter from the nominator, explaining the candidate's work and the rationale for the invitation
- The nominee's abbreviated CV and a list of recent publications
- Proposal for the graduate seminar (brief syllabus)
- Topic for the public lecture
- Plan for research to be conducted at HUJI (for semester-long guests)
- A letter of endorsement from the head of the relevant School or Institute, specifying the guest's contribution to research and teaching activities
